7.HIGHWAYS/PATHS/DYKES

There is to be a meeting with the Environment Agency, ERY Council, landowners, parish council and the Ouse & Humber drainage board on Monday 26 June 2017. 2.30 The Old School, Blacktoft. This is a meeting to discuss any further investment in to the improvement of the river bank flood defence.

Streetscene – the Clerk gave a short report on the site meeting with the ERY Council officers on Monday 12 June 2017. There are no tasks to be carried out in Faxfleet which the ERY Council is not already aware of. Following the recent road repairs and footpath repairs in Yokefleet there are no tasks to be carried out except the repainting of the bench at Ella Farm. The various tasks for Blacktoft include the hedge at a property on Blacktoft Lane, which is over hanging the footpath, to be trimmed back; stones laid in the overrun (could be a safety issue) and was passed onto Highways on Blacktoft Lane,; the repainting of Alan MacDougals bench and some failing trees to be removed at the grassed area near the jetty.

It was agreed to request the overgrown hedge at a property on Blacktoft Lane (near the jetty/double bend) also be added to the task sheet. The Clerk to contact ERY Council.

It was agreed to request the poor condition of the footpath on Sparrowcroft Lane be added to the task sheet. The Clerk to contact ERY Council.

The Clerk reported that the hole in the road on Sparrowcroft Lane had been reported several times to the ERY Council and also to the Streetscene officers at the time of the site meeting.

The Clerk reported that the request for a schedule of verge grass cutting had been requested from the ERY Council and was repeated to the Streetscene officers at the site meeting.

Highways – it was resolved for the Clerk to contact ERY Council and the (parties involved) - companies on the industrial estate, Gilberdyke Parish Council, Laxton Parish Council, Garden Centre, Sandtoft Tiles and Humberside Police to request appropriate GIVE WAY signs at the junction of the industrial estate on Broad Lane and the junction of Scalby Lane and Tongue Lane (Both in Gilberdyke parish). This request is basically to prevent accidents happening and to draw attention to the sometime careless attitude to traffic coming from Blacktoft parish by people coming from the garden centre on Scalby Lane and the industrial estate on Broad Lane.

17/01735/PLF construction of new access road from Bennetland Lane to Clementhorpe and upgrade to Clementhorpe Lane with residents parking and turning areas to facilitate the removal of vehicle traffic over Bellasize and Gilberdyke level crossings. Land to west and north east and south of Bellasize Crossing Clementhorpe Lane, Gilberdyke. (NETWORK RAIL). The parish council had no objections or observations to make other than small increase in traffic on Bellasize Lane into Gilberdyke.
