5.OUTSTANDING ITEMS FROM PREVIOUS PARISH COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES – for information only

- Street names – the Clerk confirmed that the street names will be sited by the ERY Council in the near future
- Grass verges – at Oxmaryke have been cut
- Cycling signs – the ERYC has erected public footpath signs on the top of the river bank at Smithy Lane. The Clerk has requested that a similar sign be erected at Hutch Lane in Yokefleet.
- Trees – the Clerk reported that the failed trees along 2 sections of Blacktoft Lane are still not able to be replaced because of the pathogen in the ground. It is noted that a further 2 are failing near the pump station and two (false cherries) have failed towards Manor Farm. These two trees are the responsibility of Yokefleet Estate. The Clerk will re-stake all the failed trees and label.

- Noted that some potholes have been repaired but the parish council would still like to see the whole road through Faxfleet improved to a higher standard
- Concern also expressed that flood warning telephone calls are received by some residents every time there is a high tide – the warning is for flooding of the canal and the river Foulness. The Clerk to investigate.
- It was noted by the parish council that otters are now eating ornamental fish in garden ponds at Oxmarydyke. There has also been a sighting of an otter in the river at the jetty in Blacktoft.
