8.HIGHWAYS/PATHS/DYKES

- The railway bridge in Gilberdyke – minutes from the first meeting and notes from the second meeting were received by the parish councillors. The railway bridge sides are to be replaced over a 3 week period in April 2020. There will be road closures and the heavy goods vehicles and all traffic for the industrial estate on Broad Lane will be using Bellasize Lane / Greenoak Crossing / Greenoak Lane.

- Village signs- Mr D Newby would like the opportunity to have STADDLETHORPE village signs approved and erected by the ERY Council – agreed.
- Faxfleet Lane / Tongue Lane – response from Highways ERY Council that there has been no allocation for capital to carry out any repairs to the lane but inspections will be carried out.
- Following the resurfacing of a section of Blacktoft Lane the traffic signs were covered with temporary information – these temporary signs have now been removed.
